Out of School Care (OSC)

Before School Care

We provide a variety of indoor activities including art, building, puzzles, and board games. As each child arrives at their own time and with a different energy level we try and provide activities which would interest all. The children are dismissed as a group with adequate time to get to their classroom.

After School Care

Once dismissed from school the children make their own way down to the centre (for the first few months the younger grades are escorted down by staff). The large group is divided into age groups for indoor activities.

We offer many fun structured activities and non-structured free play all while promoting inclusion and co-operation. While we support what the children have learned throughout their school day, we do not provide additional schooling or tutoring. We strive to provide activities and time for the children to release some of their energy through play. Along with many indoor activities such as painting, board games, music, building blocks, and puzzles, we also play outside for at least 30 minutes (weather dependant). A nutritious snack is also provided.

KinderCare

Our program has a strong social component, through the use of free play and structured activities we focus on making and maintaining friendships, cooperation and inclusion.

Our Kinder Leaders put together a comprehensive program including weekly themes varying from "All about me" to "space", social stories, baking, reading, outdoor exploration and play. The parents receive a monthly calendar outlining the children's activities.

As our ratio is 10 children to each adult, we have the ability to sit with children and provide extra support for them in attaining skills which are being taught in their Kindergarten classes.

We work in conjunction with the school to place the children who have registered in our KinderCare Program in the same class. We cover the portion of the day (AM or PM) which they are not in class as well as lunch.
